Quick Start

Converting a single video

To convert a single video file with the application, drag-and-drop the file onto the preview frame, or select 'Open Video' with the cursor and follow the file manager prompt to your input video:

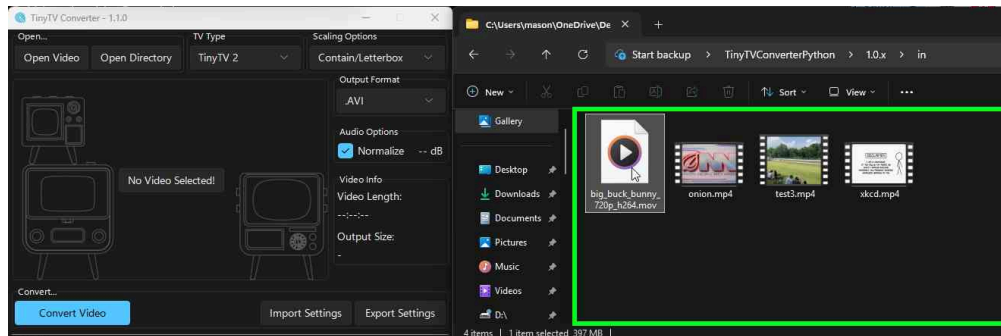


Fig. 1: Selecting a video.

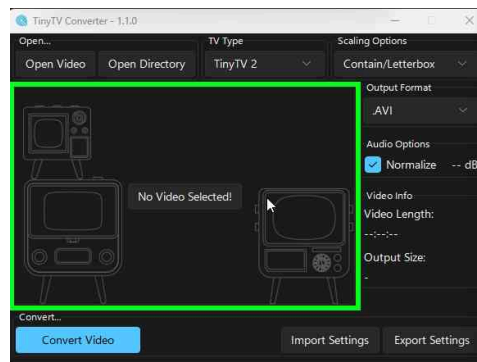
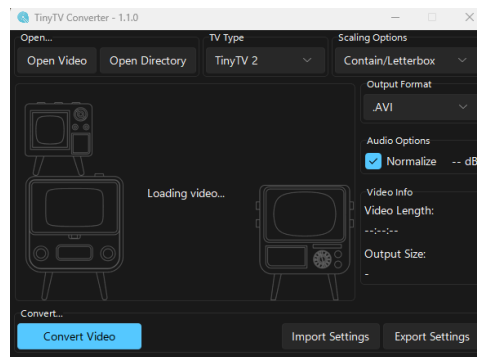


Fig. 2: Dropping a video onto the preview frame.



*Fig. 3: 'Loading video...' indicator. **Note:** may not display on MacOS.*

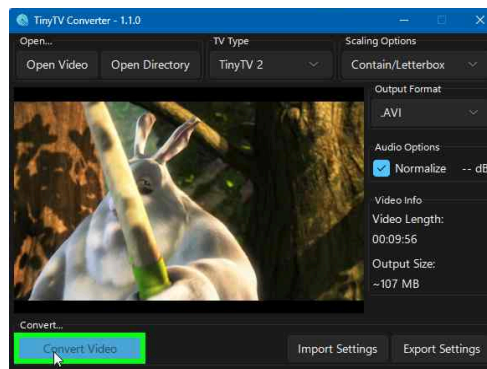


Fig. 4: Converting the loaded video. This opens a prompt for the output location.

Video conversion will begin immediately after the save-as dialog is complete. The bar at the bottom will indicate overall conversion progress. When it resets, your converted video is ready to be played.

Converting a directory of videos

The procedure for loading a batch-directory of videos is identical. A folder can be dragged and dropped to the preview frame, or selected through the ‘Open Directory’ button. The preview will show a list of all recognized video formats in the directory:

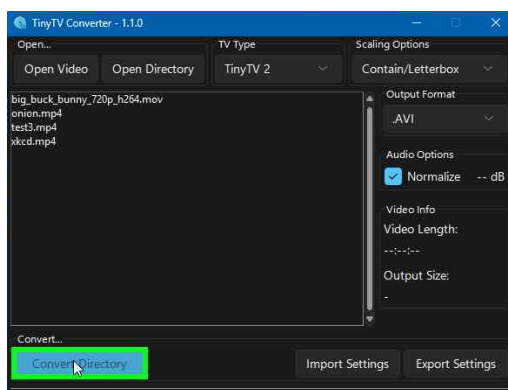


Fig. 5: Converting a directory of video files, listed in the preview. This opens a prompt for the output location.

Audio normalization

By default, the application will analyze input videos and dynamically alter the converter’s output to consistently maximize loudness between videos. This process will never decrease the relative volume of a video. To convert a directory of videos with only *some* audio to be normalized, the recommendation is to first separate the videos into two directories, and convert one with and one without normalization enabled.

Output Formats

TinyTV Kit Compatibility

MP4 video playback is not supported on TinyTV Kit hardware. Only TinyTV2 and TinyTVMini can play back MP4-formatted videos.

Video Sizes Per Minute (TinyTV2)

Saving Your Output Settings

To retain the configuration for the converter's output, select 'Export Settings' and navigate to where you'd like to store a JSON configuration file. This configuration file can be reloaded with the 'Import Settings' prompt at a later time.
